Academic Administrative Positions Working Group

Mandate:

The Academic Administrative Positions Working Group is a joint APUO-Employer ad hoc group tasked with conducting a survey of the departments and faculties and compiling an inventory of academic administrative positions, their roles and responsibilities, and related supplementary remuneration.

The working group is the result of a [letter of understanding](#) signed between the APUO and the Employer.

The joint working group will produce a report for consideration by both parties prior to the termination of the collective agreement.

The working group is comprised of two management representatives, appointed by the Employer, and two APUO representatives, appointed by the APUO. The parties will advise each other of their nominees in writing prior to the first meeting.
